## Survey Results

A total of 348 people participated in this survey.

- 32% of survey respondents live in Gonzales.
- 20% of survey respondents live in Fairfield.
- 12% of survey respondents live in Rockland.

Of those 348 people:

- 169 (48%) people said council should recognize the Gonzales Neighbourhood Association and its land use committee as representative of the Gonzales neighbourhood.
- 55 (16%) people said council should have Rockland represent Gonzales on land use issues under a unified Gonzales-Rockland neighbourhood association.
- 124 (36%) people said council should have the Fairfield Gonzales Community Association continue to represent Gonzales for land use issues (status quo).

## Analysis:

- Gonzales per capita response rate was over 4 times that of Fairfield.
- Rockland had a per capita response rate 2 times that of Fairfield.
