4. Luminary Special Event

Susanne reported that a person has come forward to voluntarily help to organize the lantern festival. Wendy will start working on the festival in mid July part time while she is finishing her schooling.

5. VCAN Biodiversity and parks map

The city is waiting for VCAN members to submit a joint proposal for \$15,000 or so to prepare the VCAN map.

6. Glenlyon Norfolk Community Briefing and Workshop Schedule

Glenlyon has begun an extensive consultation process with the community on the future of the Gonzales campus. Meetings will be held from June through to November. They are asking whether the GNA would like to host an information session with our members in October. Robin to attend as many meetings as she can on behalf of the GNA. Motion by Alan that GNA will agree to hold a GNA

meeting with Glenlyon in October at a site paid for by Glenlyon to discuss the results of the public consultation process.

7. Safety in Gonzales

Safety around Gonzales beach continues to be an issue. Discussion ensued as to how best to move this issue forward and bring it to council's attention.

8. Renew efforts to have a neighbourhood association for Gonzales

Susanne met with Anna Phelan, President of the FGCA to discuss the position of the FGCA with respect to Gonzales having it's own neighbourhood association. Anna to meet with her board to clarify their position and get back to Susanne.
