GNA Directors Meeting – March. 10, 2021 at 3:00pm via a zoom call

1. Meeting called to order at 3:05 pm.

Motion to approve agenda by Norm; seconded by Allan, approved.

2. Approval of previous meeting minutes:

8. GNA website

Alan is close to finishing the website. It will go live when the lease on the original website expires around the end of April.

9. Board Position Regarding Committee of the Whole Motion

At the February 25 meeting of the Committee of the Whole meeting staff raised concerns/questions regarding the motion put forward by Mayor and Council at the

February 4 COTW meeting. Below is the text presented at the Feb. 25 council meeting:

"The Gonzales Neighbourhood Association has not been recognized by Council as a formal neighbourhood association. A group of residents expressed their interest in having the Gonzales Neighbourhood Association recognized, but to date there hasn't been a process established to do so"

Staff also described to council what the board of the GNA is hoping to achieve by this review. Council's response to staff was that a process to date has not been created but that should not be a hindrance for staff to go to speak to the three parties involved. Mayor and Council also decided to extend the time for the review till the end of September.

Motion by Lynn to write an e-mail to Mayor, Council and staff clarifying the role that the GNA is proposing for the community. Seconded by Susanne
