Warren Gardens (1600 Block) Speed Hump Installation – Spring 2022

The City of Victoria is implementing neighbourhood traffic calming measures to reduce vehicle speeds and volumes on local streets. This work seeks to create slower streets and improve the safety and comfort of those walking and cycling to community destinations. To ensure vehicle speeds are reduced, the 1600 block of Warren Gardens have been identified for the installation of speed humps this spring.

Extent of Work Zone



Construction is scheduled to begin Spring 2022 and is expected to last one or two days. This may be subject to change, as City of Victoria construction crews manage changing priorities day-to-day. The scope of works includes:

- the installation of a sequence of speed humps; and
- the installation of speed hump signage.

The City of Victoria will work to minimize inconvenience during construction. Local access will be maintained; however, parking restrictions and traffic diversions may be required at times.
